



PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy (“Policy”) governs the manner in which Make Your Mark Digital (“Make Your Mark Digital” “we” “us” “our”) collects, uses, maintains, and discloses information collected from users (each, a “User”) of the <https://makeyourmarkdigital.com/> (“Site”). This Policy applies to the Site and all products and services offered by Make Your Mark. By accessing the site, utilizing any of the services and/or registering with us, you signify that you have read, understood and agree to be bound by this Policy.

Personal identification information

We may collect personal identification information from Users in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, when Users visit our site, subscribe to the newsletter, respond to a survey, fill out a form, and in connection with other activities, services, features, or resources we make available on our Site. Users may be asked for, as appropriate, name, email address, mailing address, phone number. Web browser cookies

Our Site may use “cookies” to enhance the User experience. Google Analytics (and other analytics uses)

We use the User-ID feature of Google Analytics to combine behavioral information across devices and sessions (including authenticated and unauthenticated sessions). We have enabled the following Google Analytics Advertising features: Remarketing, Google Display Network Impression Reporting, Google Analytics Demographics and Interest Reporting, and Double-Click Campaign Manager integration. We do not merge information collected through any Google advertising product with individual-level information collected elsewhere by our Service. We are not responsible for any information we do not collect. We encourage you to ask questions before you disclose your personal information to others.



Protecting Children

Protecting the privacy of young children is especially important to us. For that reason, Make Your Mark does not knowingly collect or solicit Personal Information from anyone under the age of 18.

How we use collected information

Make Your Mark collects and uses Users personal information for the following purposes:

- To personalize user experience. We may use information in the aggregate to understand how our Users as a group use the services and resources provided on our Site.
- To improve our Site. We continually strive to improve our website offerings based on the information and feedback we receive from you.
- To improve customer service. Your information helps us to more effectively respond to your customer service requests and support needs.
- To administer a content, promotion, survey, or other site feature. To send Users information they agreed to receive about topics we think will be of interest to them.
- To send periodic emails. The email address Users provide may be used to respond to their inquiries, and/or other requests or questions. You may indicate your preference to opt out of receiving promotional communications by following the unsubscribe instructions provided in the email you receive or by contacting us directly at privacy@makeyourmarkdigital.com and we will opt you out as fast as, or faster than, the amount of time required by applicable laws (we can usually do this within one business day). Please note, however, that you cannot opt out of receiving transactional emails related to your engagement with us.

How we protect your information

We adopt appropriate data collection, storage, and processing practices and security measures to protect against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction of your personal information, username, password, transaction information, and data stored on our Site.

Sharing your personal information

We do not sell, trade, or rent Users' personal identification information to others. We may share generic aggregated demographic information not linked to any personal identification information regarding visitors and users with our business partners, trusted affiliates, and advertisers for the purposes outlined above.
